Dear Parents/Carers,

Sails Class - Our new Reception children have settled into the school really well and are enjoying all the new experiences that 'big' school brings, although they are very tired as we approach the end of their first full week! We are also very proud to see our older children playing and caring for them during playtimes.

Parking - Due to the renovations to the house opposite the school and another house close by we are experiencing even more problems during drop-off and pick-up times due to increased volume of work vehicles. I would like to remind you that both the Three Horseshoes and the Anchor have kindly agreed for parents to park in their car parks during these times. Another scheme that would help to alleviate the number of vehicles would be to car share with another family if this is at all possible. Whereas I can understand that finding a parking space can be stressful, please can I request that you park responsibly, being mindful of the access to houses and driveways and also in a way that it is safe for pedestrians and other drivers. Learning Quests - The school has devised termly Learning Quests that incorporate the National Curriculum objectives in a more creative way and we hope this will inspire and motivate the children. We also require a written note explaining the absence for our records when the child returns to school. This can be a written letter or an email.

We ask that you return the signed acknowledgement slip back to school the following day so that we know that you have received the letter.
