2019/20 100 CLUB RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the 'Friends' bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

RULES

1. For a cost of £10 a year (running from October to July) you will be allocated one number.
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
3. The prizes will total approximately 50% of the annual income.
4. The prize money will be £15, £10 & £5 each month. There will be additional prizes of £25 drawn in December and £50 drawn in July.
5. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Burton Bradstock Primary School. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
6. Numbers are not limited per household, you can have as many as you wish.
7. Payments must be made at the start of 100 club year by cash or cheque payable to Friends of Burton Bradstock Primary School.
8. The draw shall be made by the Head Teacher or another member of the teaching staff at the last Good Work assembly each month or another public event.
9. Prizes will either be given in cash or a cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
10. The names of each month's winners will be in the school's weekly newsletter which is also published on the school's website.
11. The 100 Club will be run by the 'Friends'. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
12. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into 'Friends' funds after six months.
