Robins have learnt an animal poem.

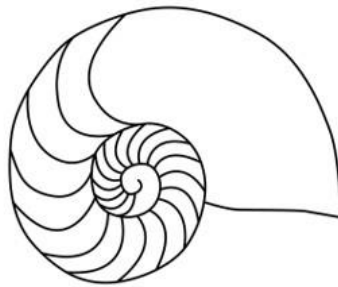
Kingfishers have been learning to play the ukulele this spring term and they played to concerts on Wednesday!
