Easter Service

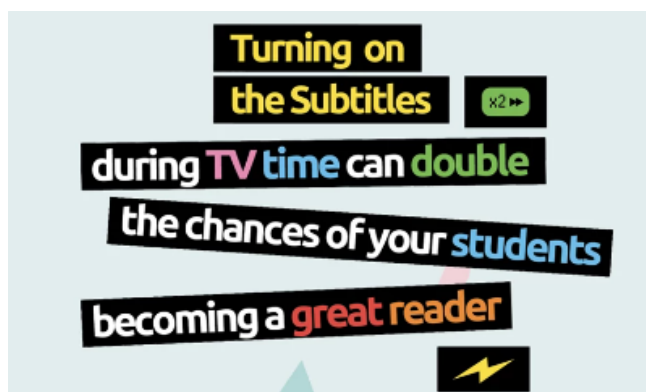
All are welcome to our Easter service on Wednesday, 27 March at St Marys Church, 9.15—10.30m.
