Owl class continue to enjoy their practical science lessons this week as part of their topic 'Light' learning how a shadow is formed.

Wednesday 8th May 2024
- Shadows (sci)

1. The shape of a shadow is the same as the object that is casting it.
2. You can change the size of a shadow by bring the object closer to the light source.
3. You can change a shadow's length by bring the light source above or below the object.
4. Shadows have sharp edges when the object is closer to the ground and a shadow is blur when the object is further away from the ground.
5. You can change the shadows direction by moving the object.
