Year 6s enjoying some football and fun on the field yesterday to celebrate the end of their SATs tests.

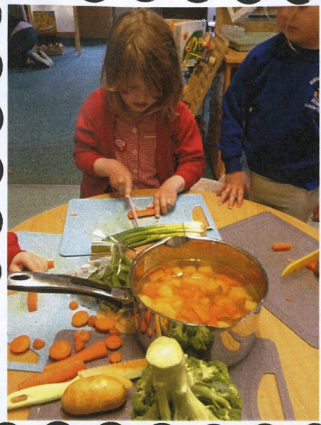
Golf Club with Mr Proudfoot

The children had a fantastic time during their first golf club using state of the art Toptracer technology at Bridport Golf Club.



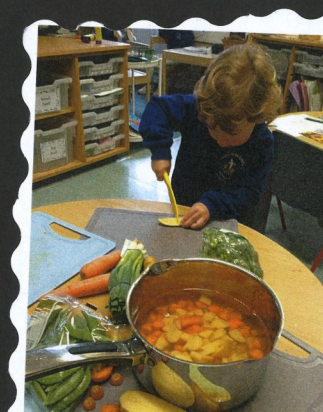
The Nest made a delicious stew this week inspired by their book 'Don't Ask the Dragon'.

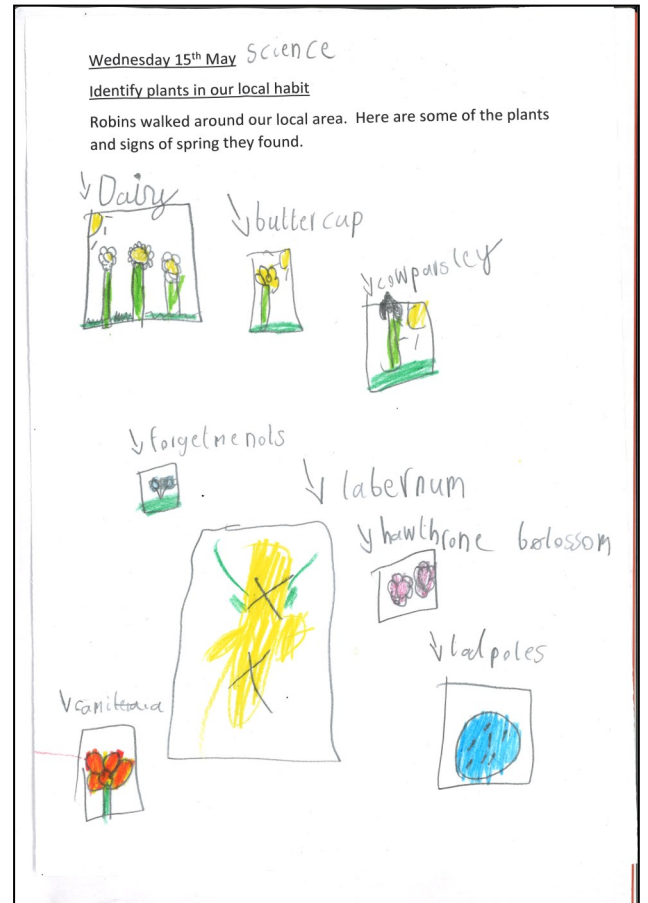
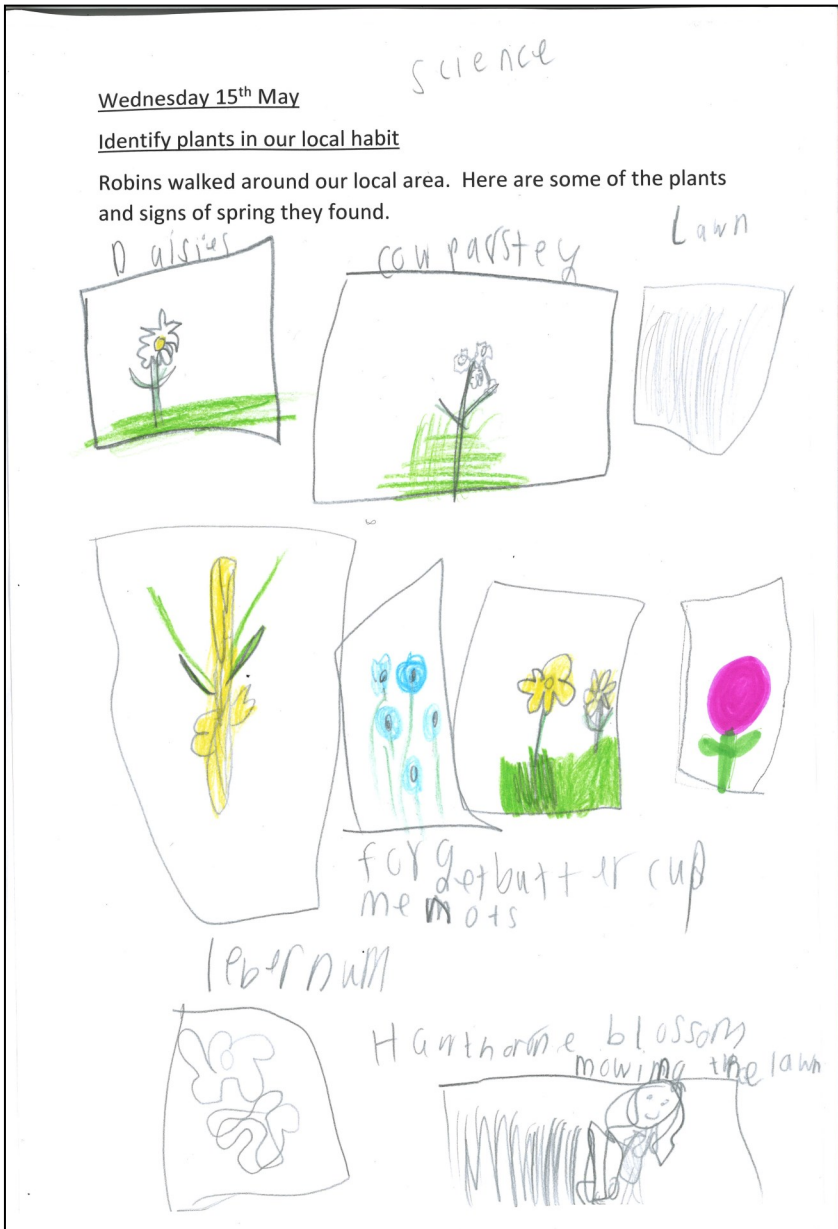

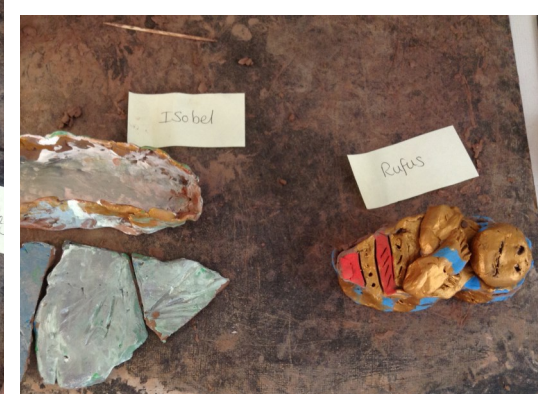
