



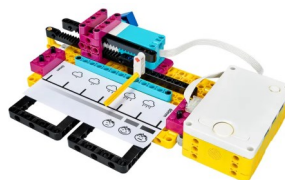

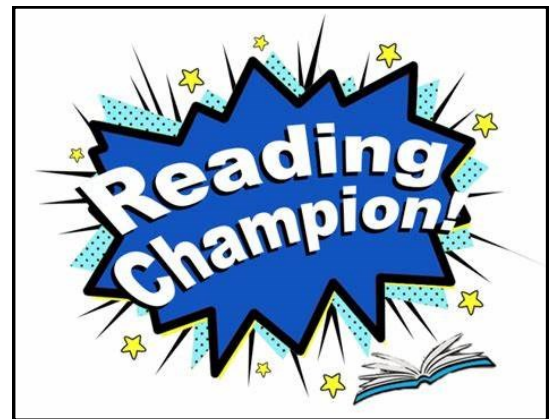
Please encourage your child to take part in this tournament - the more fluent they become at their times tables, the easier they will find more complex Maths problems.
