Don't forget that our Reading Champion Challenge has started, as you can see from the picture there are some fabulous prizes. The first winners will be announced on Monday!

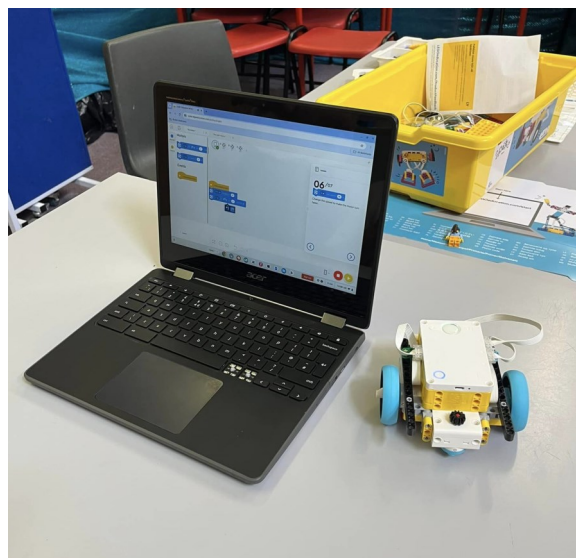
To recap the rules:

The draw for this will take place at the end of Sports Day on 26th June in the afternoon.

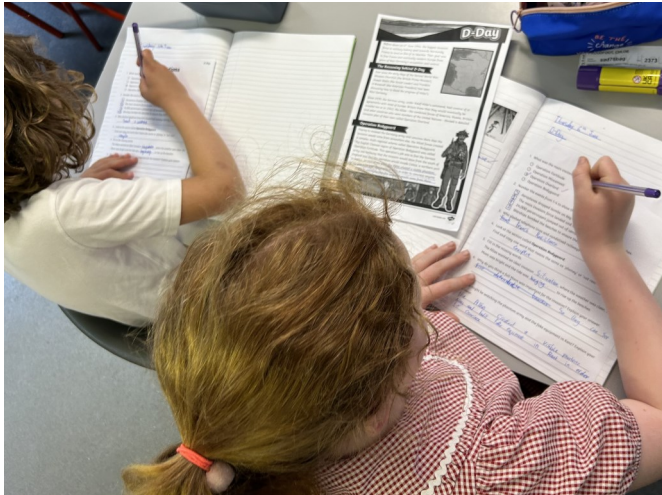
Fundraising at Bucky doo Square



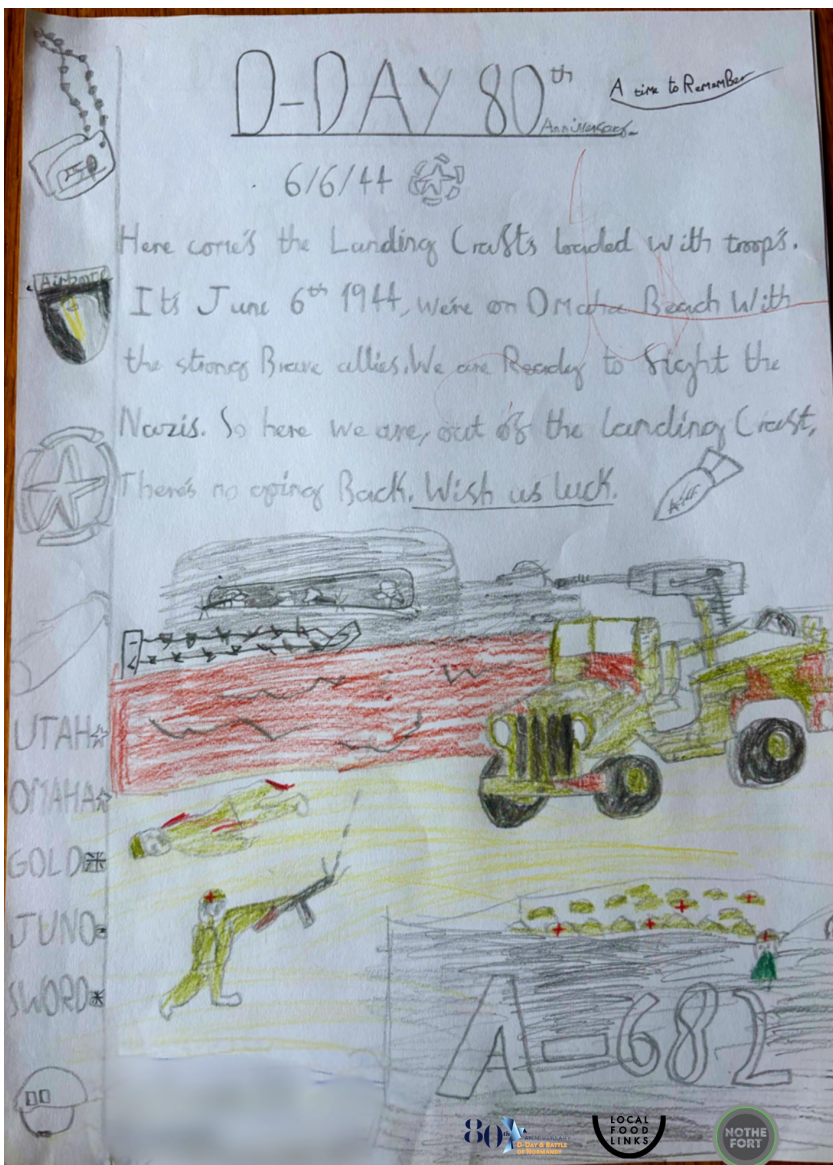
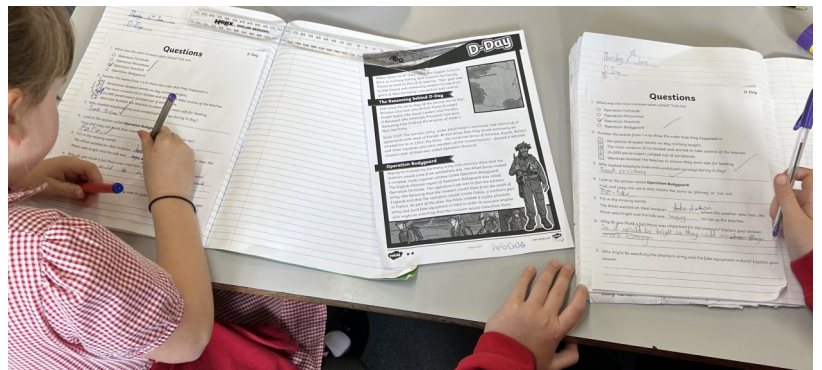
