The event will start at 9.30am and aim to finish by 11am. You are welcome to spectate and support your child's beach team at the village playing field.

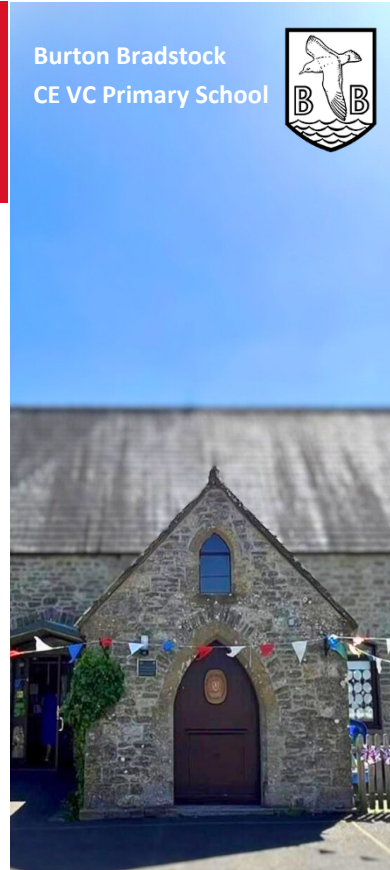
Whole School Sports Day — AFTERNOON

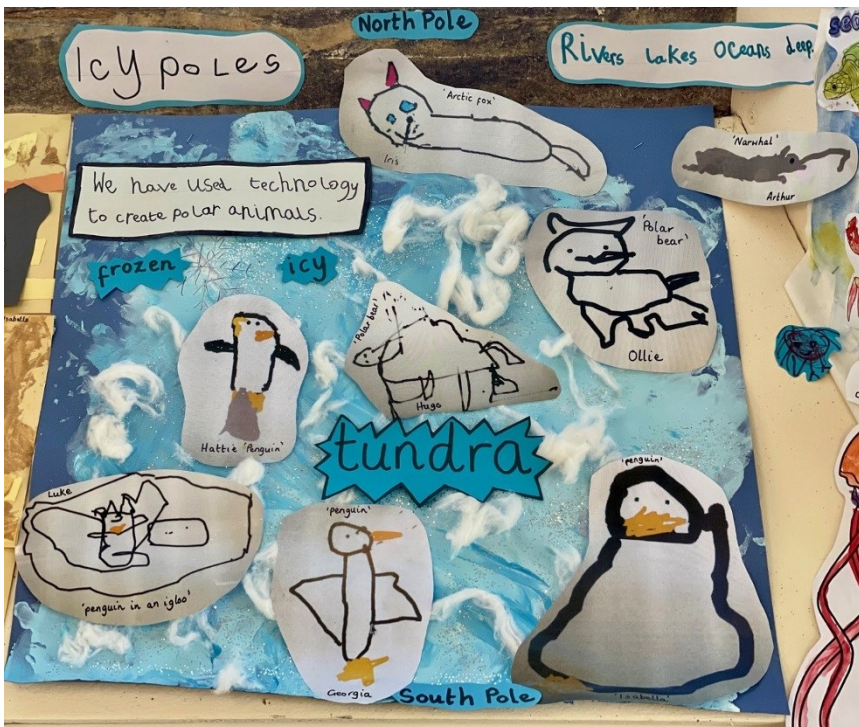
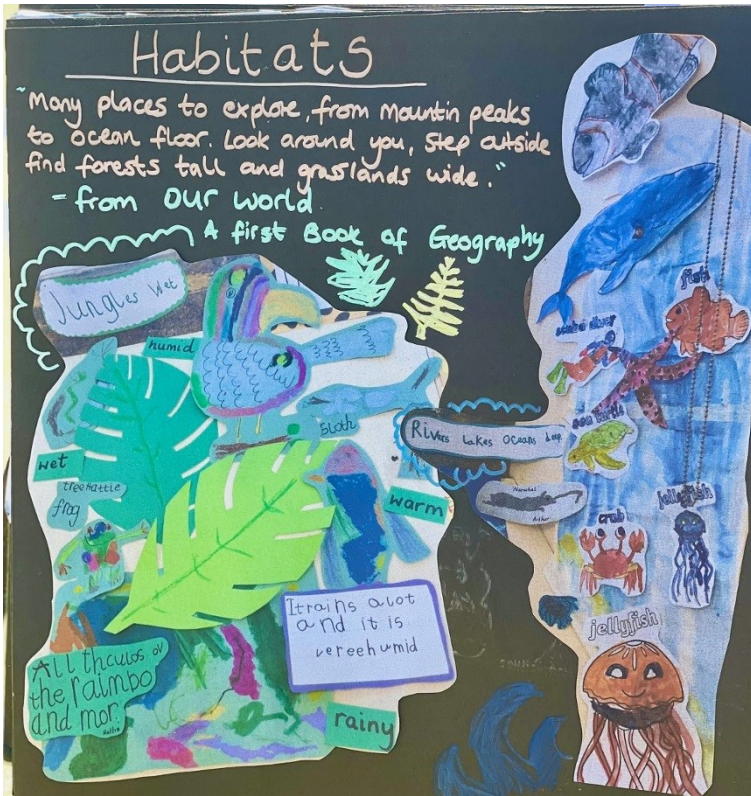
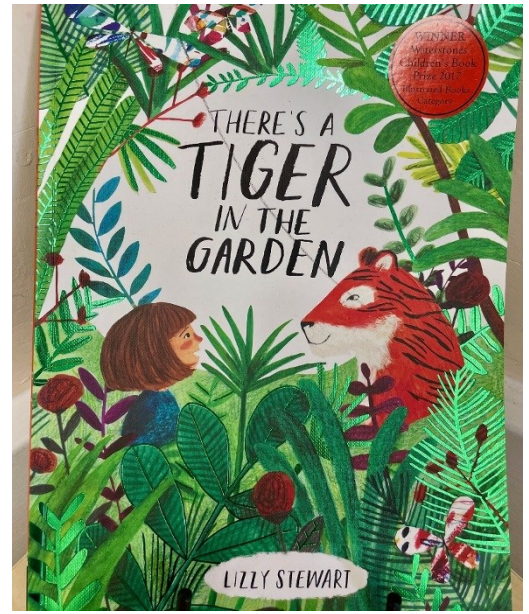
Armour & Embarkation 21 - 23 June 2024
