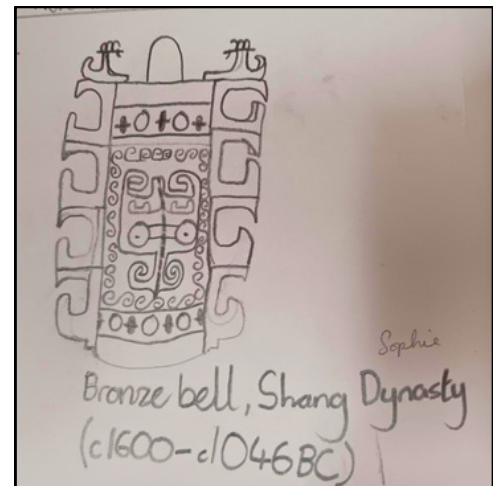
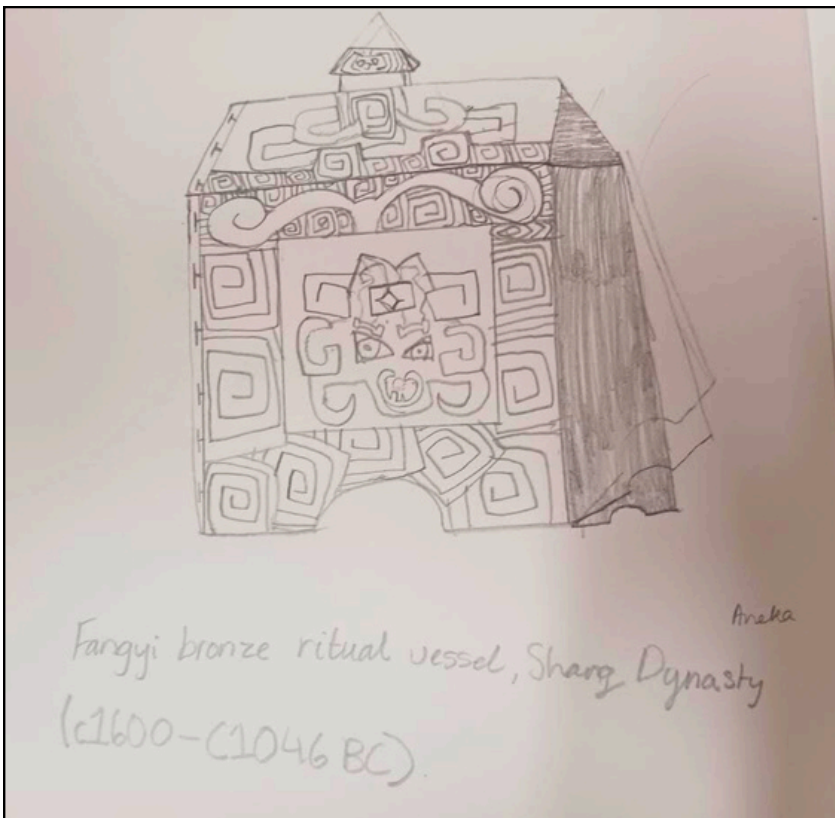


The Nest continued to learn about Festivals of Light and have transformed their classroom with the magic of fairy lights.
