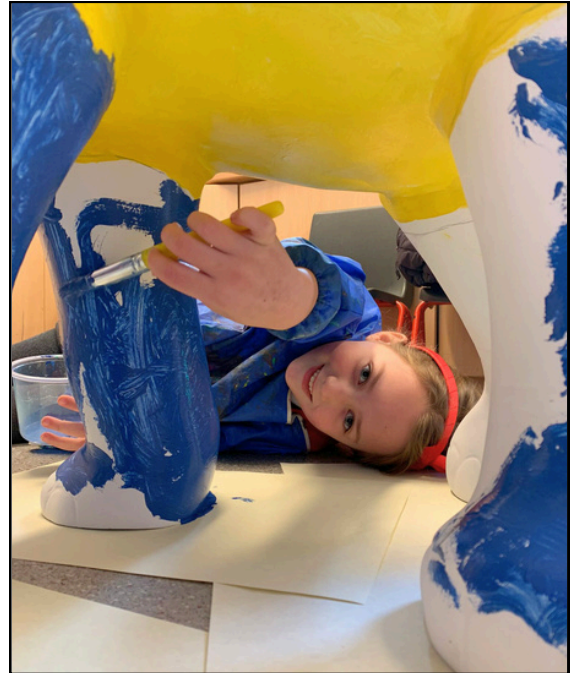
# AROUND THE SCHOOL
