Head lice

We have been notified of some cases of head lice in the school, please check your child's hair over the weekend. We also strongly encourage you to tie long hair back.

How to treat headlice?

Treat headlice as soon as you spot them

- Wet combing removes lice and nits and should be tried first.
- Wash hair with normal shampoo and apply lots of conditioner.
- Use the special comb to comb the hair from the roots to the tips.
- Do wet combing on days 1, 5, 9 and 13 to catch any newly hatched headlice. Check again that everyone's hair is free of lice on day 17.
- Some treatments are not recommended because they are unlikely to work for example: permethrin, tree and plant oils, headlice repellents and electric combs.
- Visit your local pharmacy for advice on how to remove headlice if wet combing for 17 days has not worked:
 - They may recommend medicated lotions and sprays

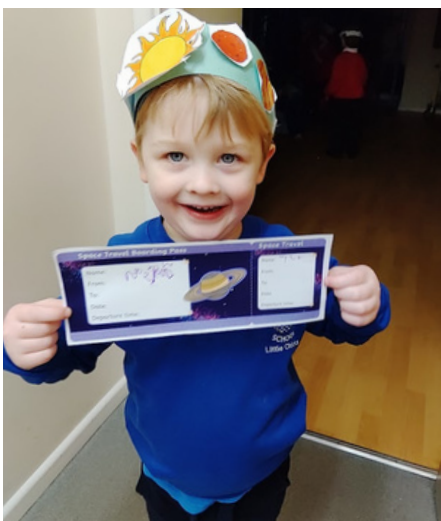
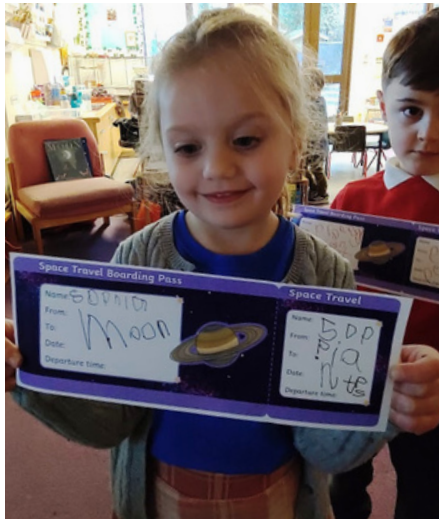


Robins joined **the Nest** to create their Christingles for today's service.

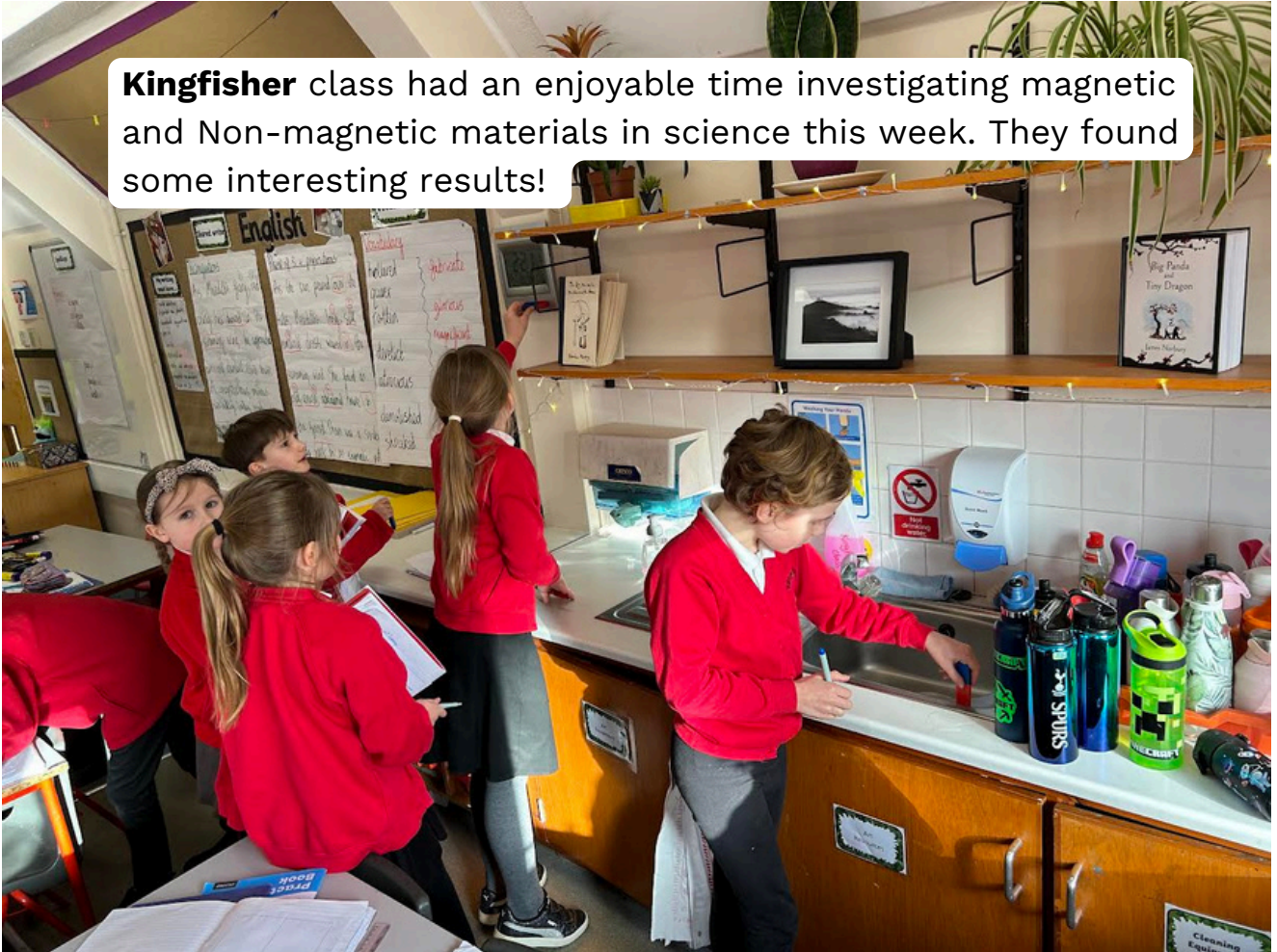

Should I keep my child off school?

Yes

Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

but make sure you let their school or nursery know about...

Hand, foot and mouth	Glandular fever
Head lice	Tonsillitis
Threadworms	Slapped cheek
