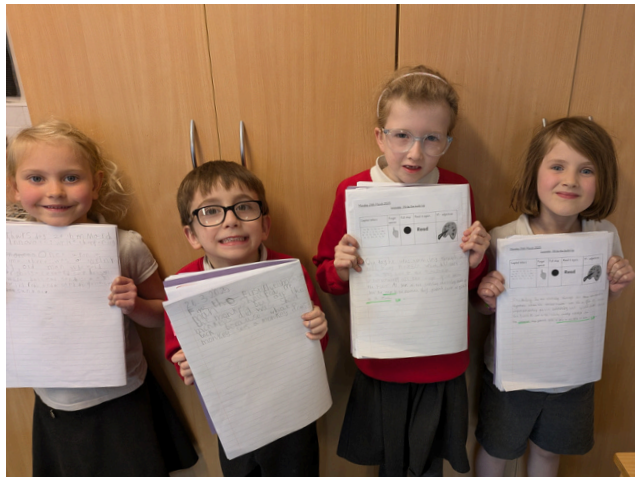
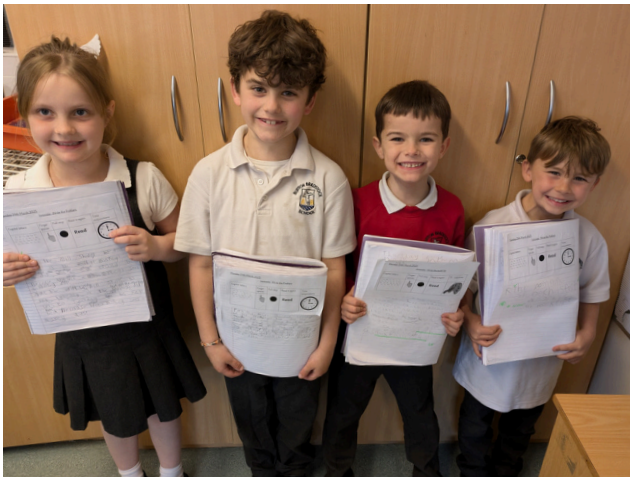
AROUND THE SCHOOL..
