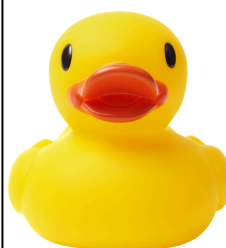

AROUND THE SCHOOL..

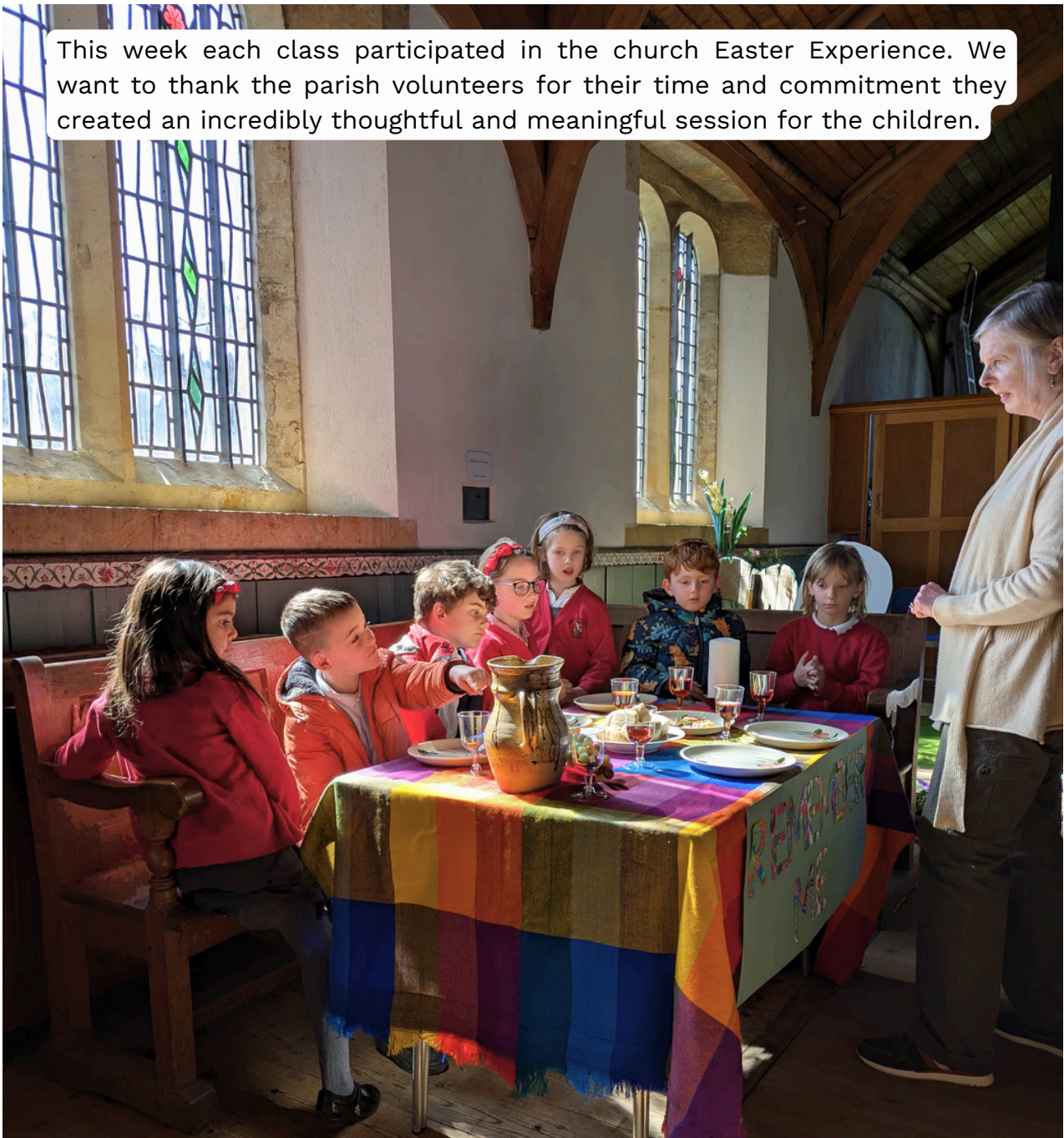
Thank you to all the families who joined us this morning for our Easter Service, it was a joyful end to the term.
