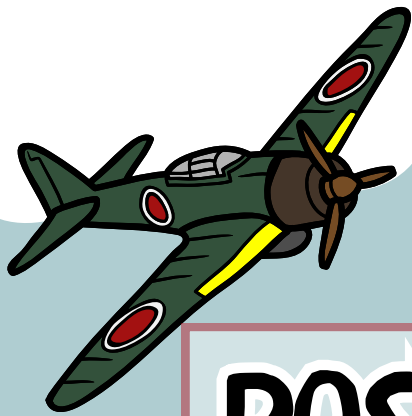
We will aim to display all the artwork around the school and there will be prizes awarded to selected designs!

POSTER COMPETITION

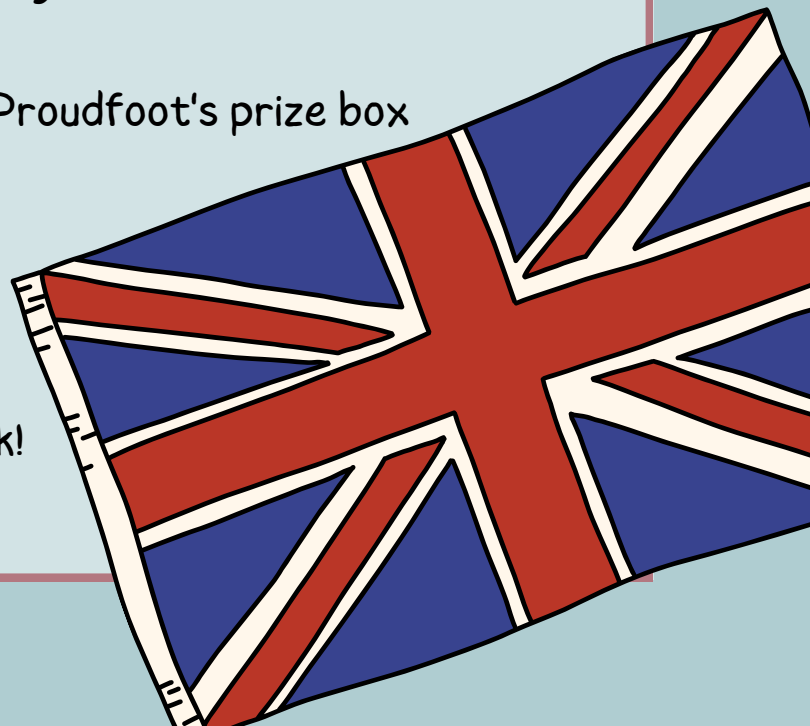
This is a special time to think about the brave and valiant people who fought and helped in World War 2.

Owls started their new topic of Groundbreaking Greeks this week. Some of them were a bit worried about eating food created from a near-2000 year old recipe, but they had great fun trying it out! We used round biscuit shapes to symbolize the moon, because the cakes were often eaten in association with Artemis, the Ancient Greek goddess of the moon.



Ancient Greek Honey Cakes

150g spelt flour
2 ½ tablespoons honey
1 tablespoon olive oil

Pre-heat the oven to 160 degrees C. Mix all the ingredients together, adding a little water to make a stiff dough. Roll the dough out to about 1cm thick and cut out with a biscuit cutter. Place on an oiled baking tray or baking parchment and bake for around 12 minutes.

Makes approx 9 biscuit-type cakes (the quantity is dependent on the enthusiasm of the dough-rolling).
