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## Burton Bradstock School Reading Challenge

### The challenge

This is a fun challenge for your child to do at home with you and their friends. Here's how it works:

- ★ For every 25 books your child reads at home, they will get a reward.
- ★ The rewards are a certificate at Wednesday's celebration and a prize from Mr. Proudfoot's Prize Box.
- ★ Your child can earn a new reward at 25, 50, 75, 100 reads, and so on.

The goal of this challenge is to help your child fall in love with reading, not to create extra stress. Please don't feel pressure to meet the goals. Just enjoy reading together at a pace that works for your family.

If you find it difficult to find time to read, that's okay. We are here to help. Just let your child's teacher know, and we'll support you in any way we can.

### Rules

- Only one home read a day will be counted e.g if you record three reads in one day, only one read will count. So, a maximum of 7 reads a week can count.
- Only home reads will count. School/teacher reads will not count towards the certificate.
- Anything from 5-15 minutes counts as one read.
- Grown ups who listen to them read need to sign the reading record.
- Any book or text can be read. I encourage exposure to different genres.
