The children loved their first Carnival Drumming session delivered by Dorset Rural Music School, they will be back this half term for more (loud!) fun.



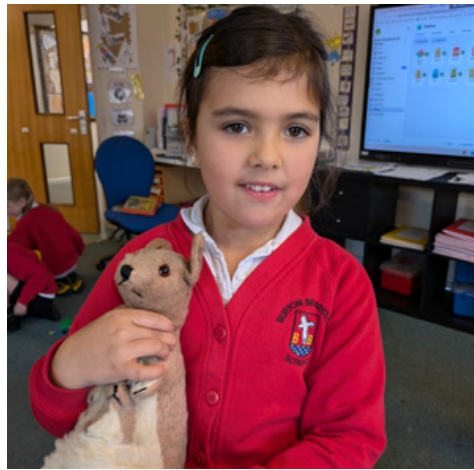
A stormy run to Hive by our running club.



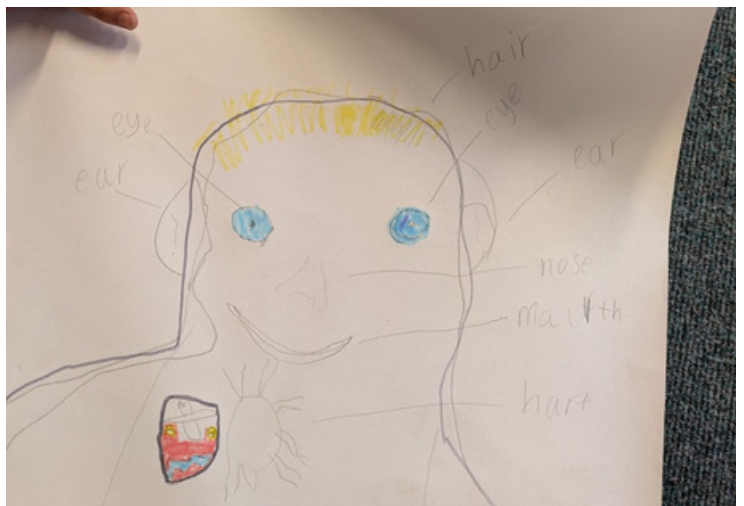
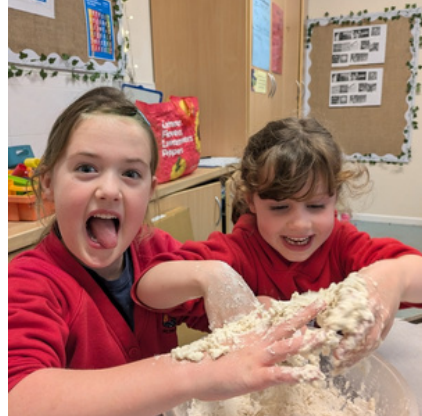
To kick off their celebrations unit, the Nest made and enjoyed sparkly chocolate bread stick 'sparklers' whilst watching a fireworks display!
