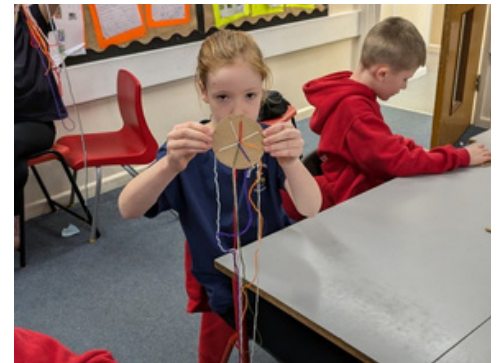
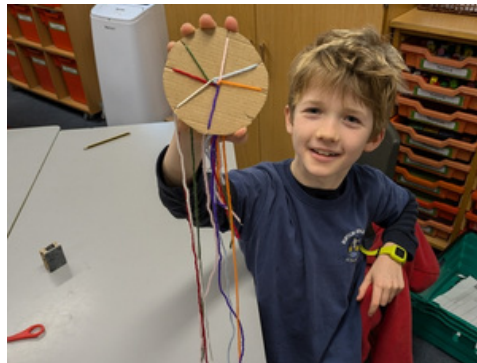


Robins enjoyed visiting the library last week. They each chose a book that they are now reading in school.
