The first running club of the year was a great success! The children ran 2.5km, including some excellent hill training on the gruelling hills of Burton Bradstock!



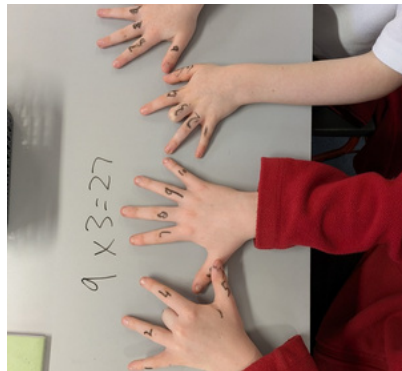
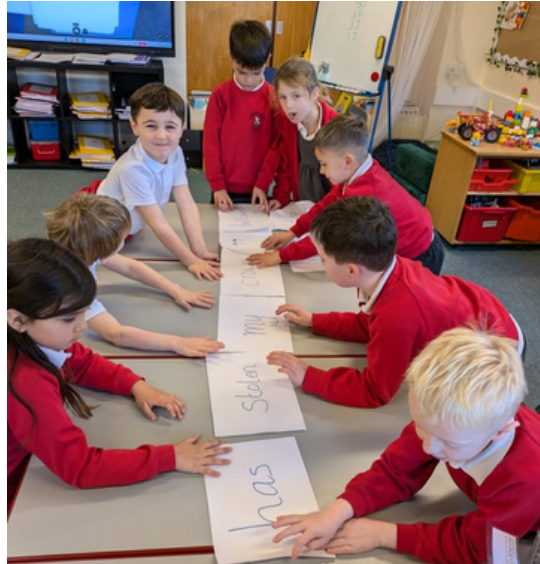
The children were very excited to get back to their Rocksteady Music School lessons last week.

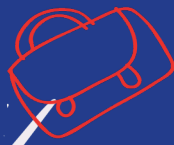

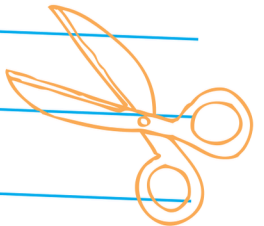
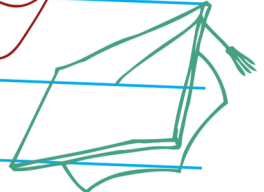
