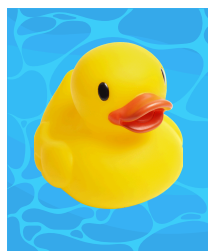

Do you have any unwanted Christmas gifts or any Christmas jumpers that the kids have outgrown? The Friends are looking for donations for fundraising activities.



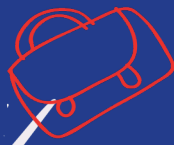
Duck Race 2026

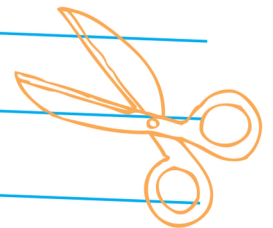
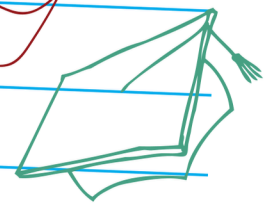
