If your child has Rocksteady Music Lessons, they may be at their Rocksteady Lesson for part of this time.

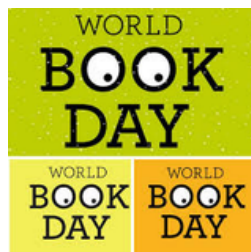
Construction Club and SATs revision are cancelled next week due to parent consultations.

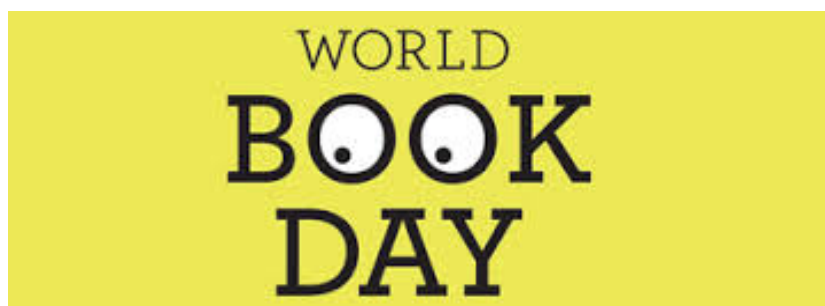

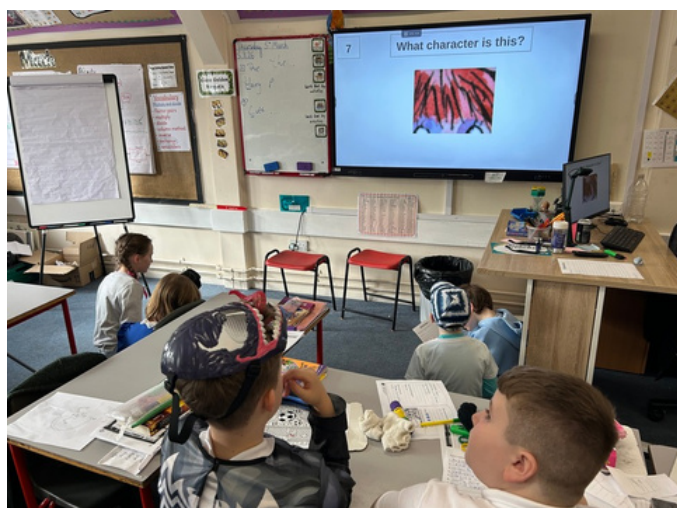
World book day Scavenger hunt:

Children had to collaborate in pairs to put their brilliant minds together to answer a bundle of enticing questions about various book characters. The pair that came out on top got a dip in the prize box!

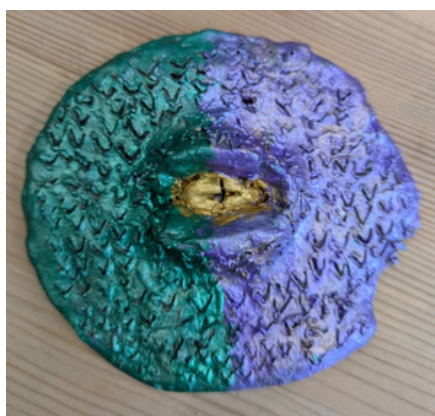




Kingfishers enjoyed the sunshine whilst tree planting at Well Plot, in Loders Village.

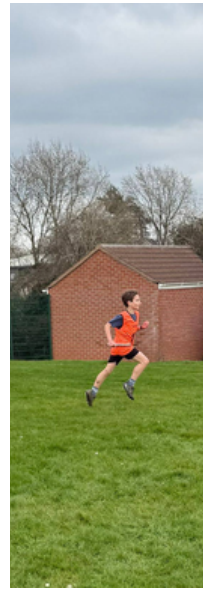


Kingfishers painted the dragon eyes they had made before half term.

We are a competitive swimming club offering swimming lessons and competitive swimming opportunities to Bridport and the surrounding areas.

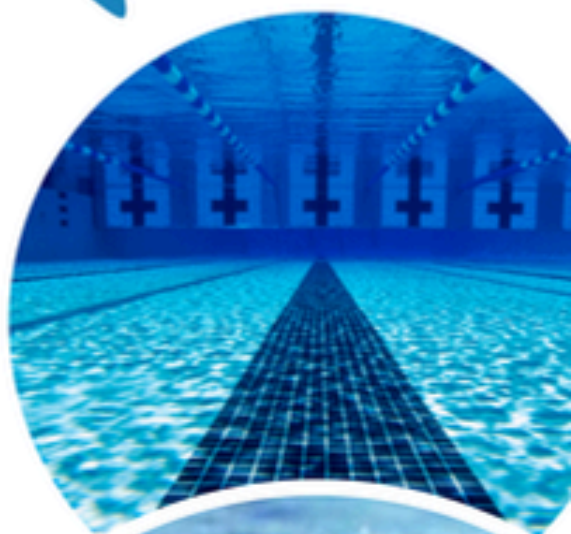
