
Key Stage 2 Results for Burton Bradstock School

Burton Bradstock school are pleased with the progress their year 6 pupils have made in 2017-18, particularly the significant improvement in Mathematics.

There were 12 in the year group so each child represents 8%. 83% were boys, 2 pupils had Education and Health Care Plans and a further 2 children received SEND support.


Scaled Scores at KS2


Key Stage 1 Results for Burton Bradstock School
